Further, one of the target locators for 2023 is a locator or tenant for the Baywalk Structure (Alfresco Building). The said baywalk structure is a CAPEX project of PPMC wherein upon completion of the same, it will be offered for lease/rent to prospective baywalk locators.  The project was bidded out in 2021 and in 2022. After two (2) failed biddings, PPMC conducted a Negotiated Procurement After Two Failed Biddings. The Notice to Proceed was issued to the winning contractor on December 29, 2022 and the Start of Contract/Project Implementation was on January 3, 2023. The project was supposed to be

									completed within 120 calendar days or until May 2, 2023. However, the contractor incurred delays and failed to complete the project on time. The contractor was only able to complete 79.92% of the project by end of December 31, 2023. As such, PPMC was not able to lease out the baywalk structure for 2023. A copy of the documents regarding the baywalk structure is hereto attached and marked as ANNEX A-6.  Thus, PPMC likewise respectfully requests for reconsideration that the said one (1) locator be excluded in the total weight under SM No. 1 and the weight be revised accordingly to 11.25%.
