


757V with control voltage of 24 vdc to 60 vdc acceptable since it is within the range and the existing Remote Control is 48 vdc only.



With regards to input of CCR, per your specs for 5kVA is 24 A, Each manufacturer has its own standard, can we offer 5 KVa CCR up to 26A input current.

The Supplier may offer more superior specifications at no additional cost to PPMC, but the maximum output voltage must be 758V and the constant current output is 6.6A. Please see below the picture of the existing CCR specifications for your reference or you may check or verify at site during the site inspection if your proposed unit is compatible to the whole system.



On the form with Notarization can we use "Appointment No." for the notarial seal of the document which is same as Serial No. of Commission as this is the standards on some notarization.
